Tips for Parents for Beginning Writers!

There are several steps that parents can do with their children to help them write their letters better and more clear. Here are some tips to help build your child's writing skills.


- **1.)** Sit down with your child and watch them write each letter of the alphabet.
- **2.)** If you notice they are making their letters the incorrect way, show them the correct way. Some common letters that are made backwards are a, b, e, and s.
- **3.)** If you notice your child is still having trouble, you can print out letters with dotted lines so your child can trace them.
- **4.)** While your child is writing each letter, have them say the letter out loud to help with recognizing it.
- **5.)** Praise your child for all the hard work he/she has has completed! You could even reward your child with a healthy snack or placing your child's work where everyone is able to admire it!
