Did You Know?

Spelling words correctly cannot only help with spelling while writing, but can also improve your child's reading as well as speaking skills. Taking the time to review your child's spelling words will increase their chances of improvement on their next spelling test along with giving them success in their future spelling.

How You Can Help

- 1. Review your child's spelling words every night until the day of the test.
- 2. Say the words with your child and help them sound them out to make sure your child can say them correctly. This helps especially when they are trying to sound out the word while spelling it.
- 3. Have your child sit in a quiet place and write each spelling word five times each to learn the correct spelling.
- 4. After they have written each word, have them say the word correctly out loud to you.
- 5. Give your child a practice or pre-spelling test the day before the test so your child can get a feel of how the real test will go.
- 6. Place your child's A+ spelling test on the refrigerator or other areas where everyone can admire it!
